This letter serves as formal notification and official record of action taken concerning the Fall 2017 Year One Evaluation of the College of Western Idaho by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) at its meeting on January 10-12, 2018. This action was taken after consideration of the Institutional Report.

Based on these materials and deliberations, the Commissioners took the following actions.

**Action**

- Accept the Fall 2017 Year One Mission and Core Themes Report

**Status of Previous Recommendations Addressed in This Evaluation**

- The Commission finds that Recommendations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Fall 2016 Initial Accreditation Peer Evaluation Report are substantially in compliance but in need of improvement

**Sanction:**

- Remove the *Notice of Concern* on Standards 2.B.1, 2.B.4, 2.D.10, 2.G.3, 4.A.2, 4.A.6, 5.B.1, and 5.B.2

**Required Follow-Up**

The Commission has rescinded the request for a Spring 2018 Ad Hoc Report with a visit and requests that the College of Western Idaho:

1. Submit an Addendum to the Fall 2019 Mid-Cycle Self-Evaluation Report to again address Recommendations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Fall 2016 Initial Accreditation Peer Evaluation Report


